True Success is found in God's Word

After the death of Moses the servant of the LORD, it came to pass that the LORD spoke to Joshua the son of Nun, Moses' assistant, saying: **Joshua 1:1 NKJV**

"Moses My servant is dead. Now therefore, arise, go over this Jordan, you and all this people, to the land which I am giving to them—the children of Israel. **Joshua 1:2 NKJV**

Every place that the sole of your foot will tread upon I have given you, as I said to Moses. **Joshua 1:3 NKJV**

No man shall be able to stand before you all the days of your life; as I was with Moses, so I will be with you. I will not leave you nor forsake you. **Joshua 1:5 NKJV**

Be strong and of good courage, for to this people you shall divide as an inheritance the land which I swore to their fathers to give them. **Joshua 1:6 NKJV**

Only be strong and very courageous, that you may observe to do according to all the law which Moses My servant commanded you; do not turn from it to the right hand or to the left, that you may prosper wherever you go. **Joshua 1:7 NKJV**

This Book of the Law shall not depart from your mouth, but you shall meditate in it day and night, that you may observe to do according to all that is written in it. For then you will make your way prosperous, and then you will have good success. **Joshua 1:8 NKJV**

Have I not commanded you? Be strong and of good courage; do not be afraid, nor be dismayed, for the LORD your God is with you wherever you go." **Joshua 1:9 NKJV**

"Remember the word which Moses the servant of the LORD commanded you, saying, 'The LORD your God is giving you rest and is giving you this land.' **Joshua 1:13 NKJV**

until the LORD has given your brethren rest, as He gave you, and they also have taken possession of the land which the LORD your God is giving them. Then you shall return to the land of your possession and enjoy it, which Moses the LORD's servant gave you on this side of the Jordan toward the sunrise." **Joshua 1:15 NKJV**

Just as we heeded Moses in all things, so we will heed you. Only the LORD your God be with you, as He was with Moses. **Joshua 1:17 NKJV**

Whoever rebels against your command and does not heed your words, in all that you command him, shall be put to death. Only be strong and of good courage." **Joshua 1:18 NKJV**

What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us? Romans 8:31 NKJV

He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things? **Romans 8:32 NKJV**

Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, **Matthew 28:19 NKJV**

THE STORY OF EASTER



With Easter quickly approaching, we will start learning all about the real Easter story! We'll learn that Jesus came back from the grave and wants to be our friend forever!

Memory Verse: Jesus is Alive. Mark 16:6b (adapted for toddlers).

Heart of the Lesson: Jesus is Alive and With Us All the Time

Parent Connect: Hang your toddler's cross craft somewhere special where you will see it and remember our lesson all week. Ask your toddler: Who's alive? (Jesus.) Say: We've been learning that Jesus is alive. We know that Jesus lives and that he promises new life to everyone who believes in him. Isn't that wonderful? Let's fold our hands, and say a prayer to thank God that Jesus lives. Say: Repeat after me. Dear God (pause for kids to repeat), thank you (pause for kids to repeat) for Jesus (pause for kids to repeat). Thank you (pause for kids to repeat) that Jesus is alive (pause for kids to repeat). In Jesus' name, amen (pause for kids to repeat).

While they are enjoying their treat ask them how do you think the Israelites felt when they finally made it to the promised land?
