At that time the Roman emperor, Augustus, decreed that a census should be taken throughout the Roman Empire. Luke 2:1 NLT

(This was the first census taken when Quirinius was governor of Syria.) Luke 2:2 NLT

All returned to their own ancestral towns to register for this census. Luke 2:3 NLT

And because Joseph was a descendant of King David, he had to go to Bethlehem in Judea, David's ancient home. He traveled there from the village of Nazareth in Galilee. Luke 2:4 NLT

He took with him Mary, to whom he was engaged, who was now expecting a child. Luke 2:5 NLT

And while they were there, the time came for her baby to be born. Luke 2:6 NLT

She gave birth to her firstborn son. She wrapped him snugly in strips of cloth and laid him in a manger, because there was no lodging available for them. Luke 2:7 NLT

When Simeon and Anna saw Jesus (Luke 2:22-40)

Then it was time for their purification offering, as required by the law of Moses after the birth of a child; so his parents took him to Jerusalem to present him to the Lord. **Luke 2:22 NLT**

The law of the Lord says, "If a woman's first child is a boy, he must be dedicated to the LORD." Luke 2:23 NLT

So they offered the sacrifice required in the law of the Lord—"either a pair of turtledoves or two young pigeons." **Luke 2:24 NLT**

Sovereign Lord, now let your servant die in peace, as you have promised. Luke 2:29 NLT

I have seen your salvation, which you have prepared for all people. Luke 2:30-31 NLT
