One Vision: Seeing as God Sees

Seeing Church Planting as God Sees

Church planting is God's plan to evangelize, gather, grow, & mobilize the church in new areas

Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, Matthew 28:19 NKJV

teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." Amen. Matthew 28:20 NKJV

But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth." Acts 1:8 NKJV

God uses the church to change people's lives today & forever

And He put all *things* under His feet, and gave Him *to be* head over all *things* to the church, Ephesians 1:22 NKIV

which is His body, the fullness of Him who fills all in all. Ephesians 1:23 NKJV

Grace's 1St Organizational Meeting – "Acts 13:4 – Send missionaries"

Now in the church that was at Antioch there were certain prophets and teachers: Barnabas, Simeon who was called Niger, Lucius of Cyrene, Manaen who had been brought up with Herod the tetrarch, and Saul. Acts 13:1 NKJV

As they ministered to the Lord and fasted, the Holy Spirit said, "Now separate to Me Barnabas and Saul for the work to which I have called them." Acts 13:2 NKJV

Then, having fasted and prayed, and laid hands on them, they sent them away. Acts 13:3 NKJV

So, being sent out by the Holy Spirit, they went down to Seleucia, and from there they sailed to Cyprus. Acts 13:4 NKJV

Grace's 20-year Strategy - "Plant 100 churches in 20 years"

After 9 Years = 28 Church Planters

- 22 trained
- 2 "grandchurches"
- 4 training now

24 churches planted, 2 are grand churches (church plants of our church plants)

Local Church in Long Island, NY

In 4 years, 88 people baptized (250 people)

Vine Hill in KCK

In 1 year, 44 salvations and 11 baptisms (100 people)

Freedom Church Downtown

In 2 years, 11 baptisms (30-50 people)
Mission City Church
In 5 years, 5 salvations and 6 baptisms (80 people)

Since starting Church Planting, 1528 baptisms (105 spontaneous in August 2016)

Pray - Give - Visit - Move

Heart of the Lesson: God Keeps Us Safe Because He Loves Us

Parent Connect: Today we learned about how God instructed Noah to build and ark and even though it rained for many days, Noah was safe on the ark. Play in a water sensory bin or the bathtub with your toddler, and talk about why God kept Noah safe in the water with his Ark.



In this series, kids will learn that no matter what happens – whether we're doing big things for God like Josiah, making mistakes like Jonah, feeling sad like the people of Jerusalem or standing strong like Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego- God is with us!

Parent Connect: Today we learned the story of Josiah. Together with your kid this week, read the story in 2 Kings 22-23 and make a snack crown together using either fruit rollups or sliced cheese
