Glorifying God with Good Works

Matthew 5:14 NKJV - "You are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden.

Matthew 5:15 NKJV - Nor do they light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a lampstand, and it gives light to all who are in the house.

Matthew 5:16 NKJV - Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.

Titus 2:6 NKJV - Likewise, exhort the young men to be sober-minded,

Titus 2:7 NKJV - in all things showing yourself to be a pattern of good works; in doctrine showing integrity, reverence, incorruptibility,

Titus 2:8 NKJV - sound speech that cannot be condemned, that one who is an opponent may be ashamed, having nothing evil to say of you.

Titus 2:9 NKJV - Exhort bondservants to be obedient to their own masters, to be well pleasing in all things, not answering back,

Titus 2:10 NKJV - not pilfering, but showing all good fidelity, that they may adorn the doctrine of God our Savior in all things.

GOD HELPS US



Read Joshua 6:1-20. From a human perspective, the battle of Jericho must have seemed crazy—both to the residents of the city and to the Israelites marching around the city. Joshua was not just confident of God's help, he was confident of the outcome. Confidence in God's help is closely connected to our belief that God is able to accomplish his will no matter how difficult the task. Sometimes God stretches our faith by accomplishing great things in unexpected ways.

Memory Verse: God will help us. Genesis 21:22b (adapted for toddlers)

Heart of the Lesson: God Helps Us When We Need Help

Parent Engagement: Make Jello and cut it into rectangular bricks. Help your toddler use the Jello "bricks" to build a wall. Remind your toddler that God helped Joshua in our story by knocking down the walls of Jericho. Let your toddler knock down the Jello wall before eating his/her snack.

Memory Verse: Give thanks to the God of heaven. His faithful love endures forever. Psalm 136:26

Heart of the Lesson: Do What's Right, Forgive - VeggieTales Grapes of Wrath

Parent Engagement: Help your kid(s) set up dominoes and knock them down. When you forgive someone, it teaches others to forgive like a "domino" effect, but someone has to start it.

For the next five weeks we are going to be outward-focused as we learn how we can welcome, pray, go, send and mobilize to reach unreached people groups around the world. We will also learn about some people groups from five major different religions, what our global partners are doing to reach them and what we can do to share Jesus with them.

Memory Verse: Give thanks to the Lord and proclaim his greatness. Let the whole world know what he has done. Psalm 105:1

Heart of the Lesson: I can be a Send-er/Introduction to Islam - Romans 10:14-15, 2 Thes 3:1, 2 Corinthians 9:7

In this series, we will be learning about how to engage unreached people groups around the world with the gospel. The students will begin their time in small groups to research information and discover different ways that they can Do Something to be involved in local and global outreach initiatives. The students will end each week in Large Group to present what they discovered.

Memory Verse: But how can they call on him to save them unless they believe in him? And how can they believe in him if they have never heard about him? And how can they hear about him unless someone tells them? And how will anyone go and tell them without being sent? That is why the Scriptures say, "How beautiful are the feet of messengers who bring good news!" Romans 10:14-15

Heart of the Lesson: What do Muslims believe and how can I share the gospel with Muslim people? - Acts 4:12, John 14:6

Parent Engagement: Discuss what makes Christianity different from Muslim beliefs. How can you share the gospel with Muslim people?
