IN THE BEGINNING

A WALK THROUGH GENESIS



In this series we will learn about God’s Creation of all things, the fall into sin by Adam and Eve, and further on to Abram’s calling from God. Learning about big stories in the book of Genesis.

Memory Verse: O Sovereign LORD! You made the heavens and earth by your strong hand and powerful arm. Nothing is too hard for you! Jeremiah 32:17


Heart of the Lesson: Creation | Genesis 1-2

Parent Connect: Today we learned about how God made the world and God made us! Our lesson taught us each day of Creation and what God made. With your kid, complete a “Creation Scavenger Hunt” and try to find one thing from each of the 7 days of Creation. (Ex. Light, dark, stars, sun, animals, fish, people, trees, water, clouds, etc.)

Memory Verse: “Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a huge crowd of witnesses to the life of faith, let us strip off every weight that slows us down, especially the sin that so easily trips us up. And let us run with endurance the race God has set before us” Hebrews 12:1

Heart of the Lesson: Jesus challenges us to be champions – Hebrews 12:1-2

Parent Connect: Ask your kid what are different ways they can “train” to follow Jesus.

Stormy Weather

In the Bible there are many examples of stormy weather, which can also represent the hard times in our lives. During this series we will take a moment to look at three different examples of people who went through stormy weather and what we can learn from these passages of scripture. We will explore how God is powerful over storms, how He is in the storms with us and how we can have perspective during storms that we may face.

Memory Verse: “I will call to you whenever I’m in trouble, and you will answer me.” Psalm 86:7

Heart of the Lesson: Jesus Calms the Storm: Jesus is powerful over storms – Mark 4:35-41

Parent Connect: Discuss as a family: what is the scariest storm you’ve ever been in? What did you do? How do you feel knowing that Jesus is more powerful than anyone or anything, and that even the wind and the waves obey him?
