GOD MADE ME
CREATION



Humans are the only beings described as being in God’s own image. Psalm 139 shows how God’s creative work in humans didn’t end with the first two. He didn’t just set things in motion and then ignore humanity. Instead, he knows each one of us and who we will become before we are even born. He created the very heart of us, the core of who we are. God knows us like no human could, and yet he cares for us and loves us!

Memory Verse: God made me. (adapted from Genesis 1:27-28)

Heart of the Lesson: I’m Happy that God Made Me!

Parent Engagement Question: Use cookie cutters to cut heart shapes out of today’s snack (bread, cheese, melons, etc). As you cut the snacks together, remind your kid that God made them.

THE JUDGES

Memory Verse: The angel of the Lord appeared to him and said, “Mighty hero, the Lord is with you!” Judges 6:12 NLT

Parent Engagement Question: Have a hair salon day or do family feats of strength together. While playing, talk about how your family can be strong in the Lord (reading the Bible or praying together)
