Our Sinfulness, the World System, & the Gospel

- The heart is deceitful above all things, And desperately wicked; Who can know it? Jeremiah 17:9 NKJV
- Where do wars and fights come from among you? Do *they* not *come* from your *desires* for pleasure that war in your members? James 4:1 NKJV
- Do not judge according to appearance, but judge with righteous judgment." John 7:24 NKJV

THE EARLY CHURCH




