### **What is child-like faith?**

and said, "Assuredly, I say to you, unless you are converted and become as little children, you will by no means enter the kingdom of heaven. *Matthew 18:3 NKJV*

### **One Vision: Seeing as God Sees**

#### **Adults helped Samuel start serving the Lord as a child**

But Samuel ministered before the LORD, *even as a child*, wearing a linen ephod. *1 Samuel 2:18 NKJV*

Moreover his mother used to make him a little robe and bring *it* to him year by year when she came up with her husband to offer the yearly sacrifice. *1 Samuel 2:19 NKJV*

Then I will raise up for Myself a faithful priest *who* shall do according to what *is* in My heart and in My mind. I will build him a sure house, and he shall walk before My anointed forever. *1 Samuel 2:35 NKJV*

#### **Adults helped Samuel learn to hear God's voice**

that the LORD called Samuel. And he answered, "Here I am!" *1 Samuel 3:4 NKJV*

So he ran to Eli and said, "Here I am, for you called me." And he said, "I did not call; lie down again." And he went and lay down. *1 Samuel 3:5 NKJV*

Then the LORD called yet again, "Samuel!" So Samuel arose and went to Eli, and said, "Here I am, for you called me." He answered, "I did not call, my son; lie down again." *1 Samuel 3:6 NKJV*

(Now Samuel did not yet know the LORD, nor was the word of the LORD yet revealed to him.) *1 Samuel 3:7 NKJV*

And the LORD called Samuel again the third time. So he arose and went to Eli, and said, "Here I am, for you did call me." Then Eli perceived that the LORD had called the boy. *1 Samuel 3:8 NKJV*

Therefore Eli said to Samuel, "Go, lie down; and it shall be, if He calls you, that you must say, 'Speak, LORD, for Your servant hears.'" So Samuel went and lay down in his place. *1 Samuel 3:9 NKJV*

Now the LORD came and stood and called as at other times, "Samuel! Samuel!" And Samuel answered, "Speak, for Your servant hears." *1 Samuel 3:10 NKJV*

### **Samuel continued to grow spiritually as a child**

So Samuel grew, and the LORD was with him and let none of his words fall to the ground. *1 Samuel 3:19 NKJV*

The show blends historical setting with biblical teachings, portraying the bravery of early Christians facing Roman oppression.

**Memory Verse:** "Instead, we will speak the truth in love, growing in every way more and more like Christ, who is the head of his body, the church." Ephesians 4:15

**Heart of the Lesson:** Jesus is worthy of our lives! | Matthew 3

**Parent Connect:** The Underground Church in Rome was very risky. People risked their lives to gather together and learn about Jesus. Set up a "secret meeting" for you and your kid where they have to know a password and location in order to hear a story about Jesus to mimic the underground Christians from our video series.
