



WORK IT - Discipling Good Works (Titus 2:1-6) - July 10-11, 2021
STUDY NOTES

Theme of Titus - who gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us from every lawless deed and purify for Himself His own special people, zealous for good works. **Titus 2:14 NKJV**

God calls us to disciple the next generation to love and follow Jesus

Titus 2:1 NKJV - But as for you, speak the things which are proper for sound doctrine:

Titus 2:2 NKJV - that the older men be sober, reverent, temperate, sound in faith, in love, in patience;

Titus 2:3 NKJV - the older women likewise, that they be reverent in behavior, not slanderers, not given to much wine, teachers of good things

Titus 2:4 NKJV - that they admonish the young women to love their husbands, to love their children,

Titus 2:5 NKJV - to be discreet, chaste, homemakers, good, obedient to their own husbands, that the word of God may not be blasphemed.

Titus 2:6 NKJV - Likewise, exhort the young men to be sober-minded,

Deuteronomy 6:4-7 NKJV - Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one! **5** You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your strength. "And these words which I command you today shall be in your heart. **7** You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, when you walk by the way, when you lie down, and when you rise up.

GOD MAKES THINGS GROW

1 CORINTHIANS 3:7



In this series, we will learn about the ways God makes living things in our wonderful world grow—things such as animals, plants, and people. Your toddler will have the opportunity to touch, smell, hear, taste, and see things that grow to reinforce the point that *God makes things grow*.

Memory Verse: God makes things grow. 1 Corinthians 3:7 (adapted for toddlers)

Heart of the Lesson: I'm So Glad That God Makes Things Grow

Parent Engagement: Help your toddler make a tall tower with blocks or empty shipping boxes. Remind your toddler that boxes don't grow but that kids grow taller every day because *God makes things grow*.

Memory Verse: Give thanks to the God of heaven. *His faithful love endures forever.* Psalm 136:26

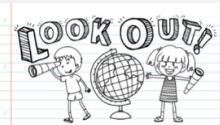
Heart of the Lesson: Do What's Right - VeggieTales Esther

DO SOMETHING

AN OUTREACH SERIES



In this series, we will be learning about how to engage unreached people groups around the world with the gospel. The students will begin their time in small groups to research information and discover different ways that they can Do Something to be involved in local and global outreach initiatives. The students will end each week in Large Group to present what they discovered.

Memory Verse: But how can they call on him to save them unless they believe in him? And how can they believe in him if they have never heard about him? And how can they hear about him unless someone tells them? And how will anyone go and tell them without being sent? That is why the Scriptures say, “How beautiful are the feet of messengers who bring good news!” Romans 10:14-15

Heart of the Lesson: What do Atheists believe and how can I share the gospel with Atheist people? - Psalm 14:1

Parent Engagement: Discuss what makes Christianity different from Atheist beliefs. How can you share the gospel with Atheist people?
