Heart of the Lesson: Jesus was Born On A Special Night

**Parent Connect:** Review today's coloring sheet with your kid. Look at the picture together. What makes each person special? When you're finished, remind your kid that God made everyone. Help your kid say, "God made me."

**Parent Connect:** In today's lesson we learned about how Mary and Joseph took a long trip to the town of Bethlehem. When they got into Bethlehem, baby Jesus, the Savior was born! Talk to your kid about how long they had to walk before they got to Bethlehem. Go on a walk (bundle up!) and pretend you are Mary and Joseph.
