

<u>The Mercy of God (Hebrews 4:14-16) – Incarnation</u> December 22, 2024

Christmas revealed the mercy of God

Jesus is our great High Priest

Seeing then that we have a great High Priest who has passed through the heavens, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession. *Hebrews 4:14 NKJV*

And if anyone sins, we have an Advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous. *1 John 2:1 NKJV*

And He Himself is the propitiation for our sins, and not for ours only but also for the whole world *1 John 2:2 NKJV*

Jesus sympathizes with our weaknesses

For we do not have a High Priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses, but was in all points tempted as we are, yet without sin. *Hebrews 4:15 NKJV*

For in that He Himself has suffered, being tempted, He is able to aid those who are tempted. *Hebrews 2:18 NKJV*

Jesus gives us His grace and mercy

Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need. *Hebrews 4:16 NKJV*

But God, who is rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, *Ephesians 2:4* even when we were dead in trespasses, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved), *Ephesians 2:5 NJKV*

and raised us up together, and made us sit together in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, *Ephesians 2:6 NKJV*

that in the ages to come He might show the exceeding riches of His grace in His kindness toward us in Christ Jesus. *Ephesians 2:7 NKJV*

As you talk to your kid about Christmas this week, talk about the presents they may get, then talk about even though presents are fun, Jesus is the best present because He came to save the world!
