Help everyone become an outward-focused follower of Jesus

Jesus is our first love, our greatest joy, & our one message

"Outward-focused" means focusing on God then others

Matthew 22:34-40, Acts 13:1-4, Philippians 2:4, 21

Now great multitudes went with Him. And He turned and said to them, Luke 14:25 NKJV

"If anyone comes to Me and does not hate his father and mother, wife and children, brothers and sisters, yes, and his own life also, he cannot be My disciple. **Luke 14:26 NKJV**

Following Jesus means giving Him your heart

And whoever does not bear his cross and come after Me cannot be My disciple. Luke 14:27 NKJV

Following Jesus means giving Him your life

For which of you, intending to build a tower, does not sit down first and count the cost, whether he has *enough* to finish *it*— **Luke 14:28 NKJV**

lest, after he has laid the foundation, and is not able to finish, all who see *it* begin to mock him, **Luke** 14:29 **NKJV**

saying, 'This man began to build and was not able to finish.' Luke 14:30 NKJV

Following Jesus means building His church

Or what king, going to make war against another king, does not sit down first and consider whether he is able with ten thousand to meet him who comes against him with twenty thousand? **Luke 14:31 NKJV**

Or else, while the other is still a great way off, he sends a delegation and asks conditions of peace. **Luke 14:32 NKJV**

Following Jesus means fighting spiritually

So likewise, whoever of you does not forsake all that he has cannot be My disciple. Luke 14:33 NKJV

"Salt is good; but if the salt has lost its flavor, how shall it be seasoned? Luke 14:34 NKJV
