What did Jesus do? (Luke 4:14-44)

So He came to Nazareth, where He had been brought up. And as His custom was, He went into the synagogue on the Sabbath day, and stood up to read. **Luke 4:16 NKJV**

And He was handed the book of the prophet Isaiah. And when He had opened the book, He found the place where it was written: **Luke 4:17 NKJV**

"The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me, Because He has anointed Me To preach the gospel to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, To proclaim liberty to the captives And recovery of sight to the blind, To set at liberty those who are oppressed; Luke 4:18 NKJV

To proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord." Luke 4:19 NKJV

Then He closed the book, and gave *it* back to the attendant and sat down. And the eyes of all who were in the synagogue were fixed on Him. **Luke 4:20 NKJV**

And He began to say to them, "Today this Scripture is fulfilled in your hearing." Luke 4:21 NKJV

Now He arose from the synagogue and entered Simon's house. But Simon's wife's mother was sick with a high fever, and they made request of Him concerning her. **Luke 4:38 NKJV**

So He stood over her and rebuked the fever, and it left her. And immediately she arose and served them. **Luke 4:39 NKJV**

When the sun was setting, all those who had any that were sick with various diseases brought them to Him; and He laid His hands on every one of them and healed them. **Luke 4:40 NKJV**

but He said to them, "I must preach the kingdom of God to the other cities also, because for this purpose I have been sent." **Luke 4:43 NKJV**

Jesus showed us that we serve people & share the Bible // In both, we are sharing God's love for them!

1 Peter 4:10-11 // The spiritual gifts are divided into 2 categories: serving gifts & speaking gifts

Who was Jesus with? (Luke 5:1-6:16)

For he and all who were with him were astonished at the catch of fish which they had taken; **Luke 5:9 NKJV**

and so also *were* James and John, the sons of Zebedee, who were partners with Simon. And Jesus said to Simon, "Do not be afraid. From now on you will catch men." **Luke 5:10 NKJV**

So when they had brought their boats to land, they forsook all and followed Him. Luke 5:11 NKJV

After these things He went out and saw a tax collector named Levi, sitting at the tax office. And He said to him, "Follow Me." **Luke 5:27 NKJV**

So he left all, rose up, and followed Him. Luke 5:28 NKJV

Now it came to pass in those days that He went out to the mountain to pray, and continued all night in prayer to God. **Luke 6:12 NKJV**

And when it was day, He called His disciples to *Himself*; and from them He chose twelve whom He also named apostles: **Luke 6:13 NKJV**

Simon, whom He also named Peter, and Andrew his brother; James and John; Philip and Bartholomew; Luke 6:14 NKJV

Matthew and Thomas; James the *son* of Alphaeus, and Simon called the Zealot; **Luke 6:15 NKJV**

Jesus showed us that we invest in faithful disciples

2 Timothy 2:2 // 4 generations of disciples – invest in "faithful men"

Judas the son of James, and Judas Iscariot who also became a traitor.

THE GOOD SAMARITAN



In this series, we will be learning the story of the Good Samaritan. We will talk about how God cares for us all the time and how we can care for others.

Memory Verse: Jesus Cares. 1 Peter 5:7 (adapted for toddlers)

Heart of the Lesson: Jesus Cares About Us All the Time

Parent Connect: Gather a variety of stuffed animals, combs, blankets, etc. Pretend play with your toddler and take care of the stuffed animals like they are alive. Comb their hair, wrap them in blankets, sing them a song, etc. Explain that caring for others is one way we can share Jesus' love. Remind them of the story of the good Samaritan and how he cared for the hurt man in the story to show him God's love.

ONE STORY - JESUS FIXES EVERYTHING

In this series, we will show how Jesus is the fulfillment of the promises we have been reading about all year in the Old Testament. His birth, ministry, death, and resurrection were all foretold. He is the Passover lamb, the Good Shepherd, the perfect prophet, priest, king, and Messiah.

Memory Verse: "I am the Alpha and the Omega—the beginning and the end," says the Lord God. "I am the one who is, who always was, and who is still to come—the Almighty One." Revelation 1:18

Heart of the Lesson: Jesus is a prophet, priest, and king and calls us to follow Him - Matthew 4, Deuteronomy 18: 15, John 18:36, Acts 3:23-25, Hebrews 4, Revelation 1:5

Parent Connect: As a family play a game of Marco Polo but on your knees in the living room. Talk about how Jesus calls us and how we can listen for His voice. Share something you learned at church today about Jesus.
