Are you trying to follow God and _____?

And Elijah came to all the people, and said, "How long will you falter between two opinions? If the LORD is God, follow Him; but if Baal, follow him." But the people answered him not a word. **1 Kings 18:21 NKJV**

Then Elijah said to the people, "I alone am left a prophet of the LORD; but Baal's prophets are four hundred and fifty men. **1 Kings 18:22 NKJV**

Therefore let them give us two bulls; and let them choose one bull for themselves, cut it in pieces, and lay it on the wood, but put no fire under it; and I will prepare the other bull, and lay it on the wood, but put no fire under it. **1 Kings 18:23 NKJV**

Then you call on the name of your gods, and I will call on the name of the LORD; and the God who answers by fire, He is God." So all the people answered and said, "It is well spoken." **1 Kings 18:24 NKJV**

The God who answers, is the true God.

And so it was, at noon, that Elijah mocked them and said, "Cry aloud, for he is a god; either he is meditating, or he is busy, or he is on a journey, or perhaps he is sleeping and must be awakened." **1 Kings 18:27 NKJV**

So they cried aloud, and cut themselves, as was their custom, with knives and lances, until the blood gushed out on them. **1 Kings 18:28 NKJV**

And when midday was past, they prophesied until the time of the offering of the evening sacrifice. But there was no voice; no one answered, no one paid attention. **1 Kings 18:29 NKJV**

False gods will always fail you.

Then Elijah said to all the people, "Come near to me." So all the people came near to him. And he repaired the altar of the LORD that was broken down. **1 Kings 18:30 NKJV**

And it came to pass, at the time of the offering of the evening sacrifice, that Elijah the prophet came near and said, "LORD God of Abraham, Isaac, and Israel, let it be known this day that You are God in Israel and I am Your servant, and that I have done all these things at Your word. **1 Kings 18:36 NKJV**

Hear me, O LORD, hear me, that this people may know that You are the LORD God, and that You have turned their hearts back to You again." **1 Kings 18:37 NKJV**

Then the fire of the LORD fell and consumed the burnt sacrifice, and the wood and the stones and the dust, and it licked up the water that was in the trench. **1 Kings 18:38 NKJV**

Now when all the people saw it, they fell on their faces; and they said, "The LORD, He is God! The LORD, He is God!" **1 Kings 18:39 NKJV**

The Lord is the one true God.

Memory Verse: God is strong and always ready to help us. Psalm 46:1 (adapted for toddlers)

Heart of the Lesson: God Is Strong and Helps Us

Parent Connect: Today we made a craft to remind us that we can praise God because he is strong and helps us. Listen to kids worship music and sing and dance with your kid while they shake their egg shaker craft.



This month we will be exploring more of the kings and prophets of Israel and Judah. Some kings followed God; most did not. God used the prophets to encourage the people to turn back to God.

Memory Verse: "Be still, and know that I am God! I will be honored by every nation. I will be honored throughout the world." Psalm 46:10

Heart of the Lesson: The Lord is God: Elijah on Mt. Carmel - 1 Kings 18

Parent Connect: Play hide and seek as a family. When you're finished remind your kid that the prophet Elijah had to hide from wicked King Ahab and his mean wife Jezebel. Say: It's fun to play hide and seek with your family, but do you think it is fun to hide for your life?
