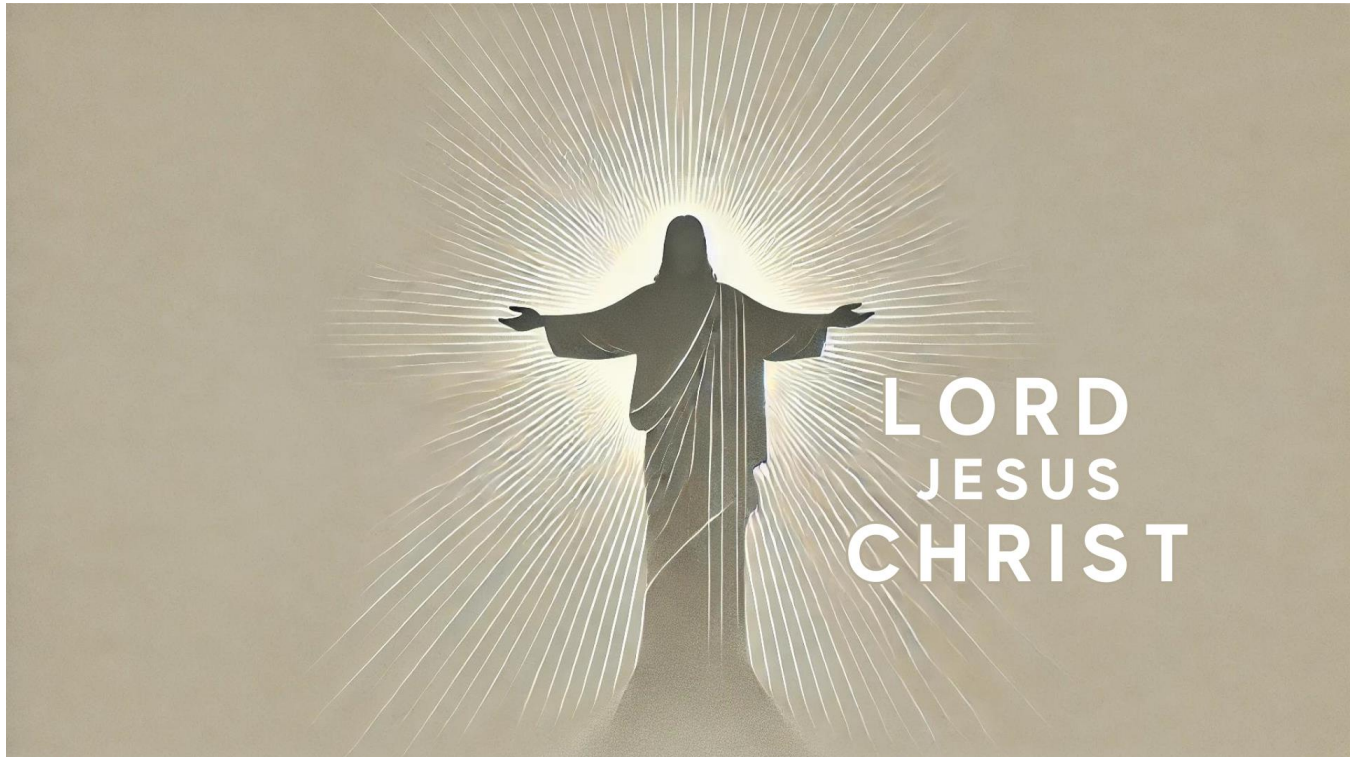

Lord Jesus Christ is a name above all names

Therefore God also has highly exalted Him and given Him the name which is above every name,
Philippians 2:9 NKJV

that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of those in heaven, and of those on earth, and of those under the earth, **Philippians 2:10 NKJV**

and that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

What does the name Jesus mean?

These *are* the names of the men whom Moses sent to spy out the land. And Moses called Hoshea the son of Nun, Joshua. **Numbers 13:16 NKJV**

And she will bring forth a Son, and you shall call His name JESUS, for He will save His people from their sins." **Matthew 1:21 NKJV**

And in that day you will say: "O Lord, I will praise You; Though You were angry with me, Your anger is turned away, and You comfort me. **Isaiah 12:1 NKJV**

Behold, **God is my salvation**, I will trust and not be afraid; 'For **Yah, the Lord**, is my strength and song; He also has become my salvation.' " **Isaiah 12:2 NKJV**

What is God the Father's perspective on Jesus?

Jesus is God's only begotten Son

For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life. **John 3:16 NKJV**

No one has seen God at any time. The only begotten Son, who is in the bosom of the Father, He has declared *Him*. **John 1:18 NKJV**

Jesus is God's Beloved Son

And the Holy Spirit descended in bodily form like a dove upon Him, and a voice came from heaven which said, "You are My beloved Son; in You I am well pleased." **Luke 3:22 NKJV**

What does Jesus' name mean to us?

Jesus' name gives us forgiveness

To Him all the prophets witness that, through His name, whoever believes in Him will receive remission of sins." **Acts 10:43 NKJV**

Jesus' name gives us power

And whatever you ask in My name, that I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. **John 14:13 NKJV**

If you ask anything in My name, I will do *it* **John 14:14 NKJV**

Jesus' name gives us purpose

And whatever you do in word or deed, *do* all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him. **Colossians 3:17 NKJV**

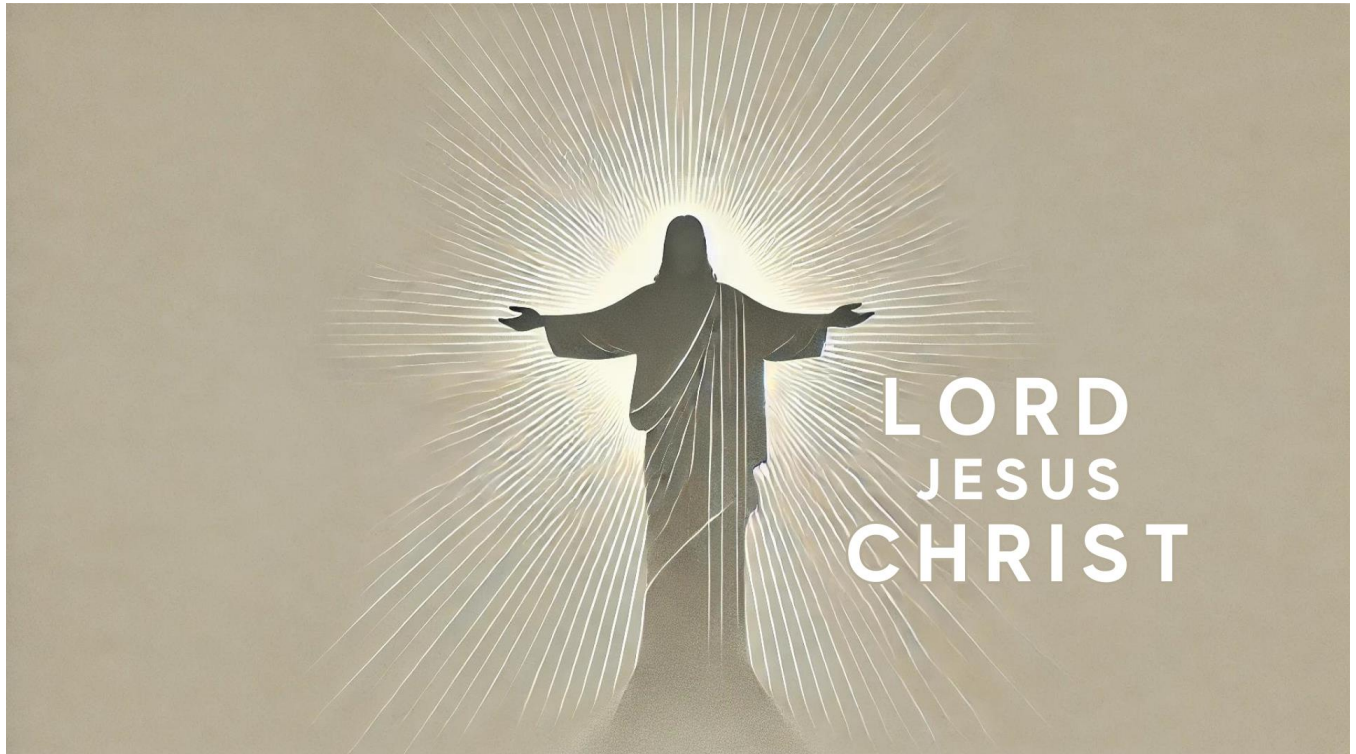

Parent Connect: Remind your toddler of the story of the Good Samaritan. Talk about different people that God sends to care for us (parents, grandparents, doctors, teachers, etc). Help your kid color a picture to give the helper of their choice. Write "Thank you for caring for me" on the paper. Take your kid to deliver his/her special note.

JUDGES AND PROPHETS



This series will go into the different ways different people decided to listen to God and to follow His plan for them!

Memory Verse: "The angel of the Lord appeared to him and said, 'Mighty hero, the Lord is with you!'" Judges 6:12

Heart of the Lesson: Samuel the Prophet | 1 Samuel 1, 3

Parent Connect: Today we learned about Samuel, Hannah's son, who grew up learning how to listen to God's voice. Samuel heard God calling him one night but thought it was Eli! Talk to your kid about how God can speak to us in our heart, through the Bible, through other people. Go outside and practice listening for each other's voices by playing 'Marco, Polo'.

The ultimate Life Hack

THE ABCS OF LIVING FOR JESUS



Memory Verse: "If you openly declare that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved." Romans 10:9

Heart of the Lesson: Because Jesus is Lord, we can ADMIT our sins to him – John 13:1-12 and Romans 3:23

Parent Connect: Read John 13:1-8 together. Ask your kids what it would be like for Jesus to come in your dining room and want to wash your feet. How would you feel? Take a bowl of water and a towel and act out what it might have been like for Jesus to wash the disciples' feet. Take turns playing each role.

Lord Jesus Christ

In this series, we will be seeking to understanding what the names “Lord”, “Jesus”, and “Christ” mean and how we should respond. We will go through interactive stations and discussion questions that give students the opportunity to reflect on who Jesus is in their life personally.

Memory Verse: “Then the name of our Lord Jesus will be honored because of the way you live, and you will be honored along with him. This is all made possible because of the grace of our God and Lord, Jesus Christ.” 2 Thessalonians 1:12

Heart of the Lesson: Who is Lord? Lord means that Jesus is in charge (Revelation 19:16, Luke 6:46)

Parent Connect: Have a conversation with your student about who oversees various parts of their lives (you, the parent, teachers, principle, coach) and how having Jesus be the Lord of their life affects those situations. It is good to make a game plan for when another leader over them asks them to do something that isn’t in accordance with the will of God.

Did you know names and titles have meanings? We can learn about people because of their names and titles! The same is true of Jesus. We can learn about Him by studying the things He is called! This series, we’re learning that Jesus is Lord, our Savior, and the One we’ve waited for!

Memory Verse: And there is only one Lord. He is Jesus Christ. All things came because of him, and we live because of him. (1 Corinthians 8:6b)

Heart of the Lesson: Jesus is Lord (Revelation 19:16, Luke 6:46-49, & Philippians 2:9-11)

Parents/Caregivers:

- What does it mean that Jesus is Lord?
- Do you show that Jesus is Lord with your words or your actions?
- How can you take part in helping everyone know that “Jesus is Lord?”
- Who do you want to tell that “Jesus is Lord” this week?
