

<u>The Freedom (Hebrews 2:9-10, 14-15) – Incarnation</u> December 15, 2024

Jesus came to set us free

Christmas revealed the freedom of God

But we see Jesus, who was made a little lower than the angels, for the suffering of death crowned with glory and honor, that He, by the grace of God, might taste death for everyone. **Hebrews 2:9 NKJV**

For it was fitting for Him, for whom are all things and by whom are all things, in bringing many sons to glory, to make the captain of their salvation perfect through sufferings. **Hebrews 2:10 NKJV**

Inasmuch then as the children have partaken of flesh and blood, He Himself likewise shared in the same, that through death He might destroy him who had the power of death, that is, the devil, **Hebrews 2:14 NKJV**

and release those who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage. **Hebrews** 2:15 NKJV

Jesus came to set us free from the devil <u>No Need to Fear</u>

Luke 10:17-21, Hebrews 2:14, James 4:7, 1 John 2:13-14, 1 John 4:4 ...that He might destroy him who had the power of death, that is, the devil, **Hebrews 2:14 NKJV** Jesus & the devil (Matthew 4:1-11)

Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you. Draw near to God and He will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners; and purify your hearts, you double-minded. **James 4:7-8 NKJV**

Heart of the Lesson: The Animals Gave Jesus A Bed

Parent Connect: Pull out your family nativity or a kid's nativity and look at the different animals included. Can your toddler name the animals and name their animal sounds? Ask your toddler, "What did the animals give to Baby Jesus?" (Their feed box as a bed.)



This series will go through the birth of Jesus, starting with an angel bringing good news to Mary and Joseph. Then, wrapping up with Jesus being dedicated at the temple. What a wonderful series to celebrate our Savior, Jesus Christ!

Heart of the Lesson: An Angel Appears to the Shepherds | Luke 2, Matthew 2:1-6

Parent Connect: Today we learned about how an angel appeared to the shepherds telling them that Jesus was born and to go worship Him! Talk to your kids about how you can worship Jesus this Christmas season; singing worship songs about His birth, caring for others by bringing them a treat, praying and thanking God for sending Jesus as our Savior!
